## AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A PUBLIC DANCE HALL A NUISANCE; PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF A PUBLIC DANCE HALL WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF KRESS, TEXAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND SUSPENDING THE RULE REQUIRING THE READING OF AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KRESS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the operation of public dance halls is hereby declared to be a nuisance and that from henceforth it shall be unlawful for any firm, person or corporation to operate a public dance hall within the city limits of the city of Kress, Texas.

visions of this Ordinance, or shall fail to comply therewith or with any of the requirements thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a fine, and upon conviction of any such violation shall be fined in any sum of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00); and each day any such violation shall be permitted to exist shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION 3. The Ordinance rule requiring the reading of an ordinance on three separate days be and the same is hereby suspended and this Ordinance shall become effective as provided by the Charter of the City of Kress, Texas.
