AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY NEAR THE CITY OF KRESS, TEXAS, AND AUTHOR-IZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KRESS, TEXAS:

Section 1. On the 30th day of November, 1964, at 8:00 o'clock P. M., in the City Council chamber of the City Hall of the City of Kress, Texas, the City Council will hold a public hearing giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation by the City of Kress, Texas, of the following described property, to-wit:

A portion of the Northwest part of Section No. 52, in Block M-13, in Swisher County, Texas, described by metes and bounds as follows: BEGINNING 40 feet South and 180 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Section No. 52, in Block M-13, in Swisher County, Texas; THENCE East 1098.9 feet to a point; THENCE South 462 feet to a point; THENCE along a curve to the N. W. whose center bears North 1181.95 feet, a curve distance of 311.45 feet to the P.R.C. of a curve; THENCE along a curve to the left whose center bears South 1121.95 feet, a curve distance of 295.65 feet to its P.T.; THENCE West 399.2 feet to a point; THENCE North 210 feet to a point; THENCE West 99.7 feet to a point; THENCE North 180 feet to the beginning and containing 13.4 acres more or less.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Kress, Texas, is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in the city and in the above described territory not more than twenty (20) days nor less than ten (10) days prior to the date of such public hearing, all in accordance with the Municipal Annexation Act (Chapter No. 160, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963; compiled as Article 970a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes).
