

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OR EX-  
PLOSION OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE  
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF KRESS, TEXAS, AND  
PROVIDING A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$100.00 FOR  
VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF  
KRESS, TEXAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm,  
corporation or other legal entity to sell, offer for sale,  
discharge, fire or set off any pyrotechnic exhibition, rocket,  
blue light, squib, cracker, or other fireworks whatever.

Section 2. Each such act shall be considered a separate  
offense.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of  
this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not  
less than \$5.00 and not more than \$100.00 for each such offense.
