

Residential Senior Citizen Rate:

- \$25.00 Senior Citizen age 65 with a 2000 gallon minimum. Plus an additional \$2.86 per thousand from 2,001-10,000 gallons.
- \$41.74 for the first 3,000 gallons (minimum) plus an additional;
- \$2.86 per thousand from 3,001-10,000 gallons
- \$4.02 per thousand from 10,001-25,000 gallons
- \$6.05 per thousand from 25,001-50,000 gallons
- \$7.64 per thousand any over 50,001 gallons.

Residential rate, City Employee, Volunteer Fire Dept, City Council, Mayor

- \$4.50 for the first 10,000 gallons (minimum) plus an additional;
- \$2.08 per thousand from 10,001-25,000 gallons
- \$2.91 per thousand from 25,001-50,000 gallons
- \$4.38 per thousand any over 50,001 gallons.

Commercial/Industrial Rate:

- \$46.28 for the first 3,000 gallons (minimum) plus an additional;
- \$2.86 per thousand from 3,001-10,000 gallons
- \$4.02 per thousand from 10,001-25,000 gallons
- \$6.05 per thousand from 25,001-50,000 gallons
- \$7.64 per thousand any over 50,001 gallons.

Sewer Rates

A monthly flat rate fee for sewer service shall be as follows:

Residential rate (based on water consumption). \$22.81 (minimum) plus an additional: \$0.15 per thousand from 7,001-20,000 gallons; and \$0.30 per thousand any over 20,001.

Commercial/ Industrial rate (based on water consumption). \$29.81 (minimum) plus an additional: \$0.15 per thousand from 7,001-20,000 gallons; and \$0.30 per thousand any over 20,001.

Senior Citizen age 65 (based on water consumption). \$16.00 (minimum) plus an additional: \$0.25 per thousand from 7,001-20,000 gallons; and \$0.40 per thousand any over 20,001.

Residential rate for city employee, Volunteer Fire Dept, City Council, Mayor \$4.50 (minimum) plus an additional: \$0.25 per thousand from 7,001-20,000 gallons; and \$0.40 per thousand any over 20,001

Sewer connections outside of the city limits shall have \$6.50 added to the base sewer rate.

Sewer Tap Location Fees

- The sewer tap location fee shall be \$35.00.
- Sewer tap fee shall be \$750
- Rates for all taps may be adjusted by the utility director if unusual circumstances are encountered or to include main line extensions.
- Outside the city limits, add \$3,500.00 per tap.

Water Tap Fees

- 3/4-inch tap \$1,000.00
- 1-inch tap \$1,600.00
- 1.5-inch tap \$2,800.00
- 2-inch tap \$3,450.00

The rate for taps larger than 2 inches will be determined by the utility director based on the actual cost to the city at the time of application.

Rates for all taps may be adjusted by the utility director if unusual circumstances are encountered or to include main line extensions.

Outside the city limits, add \$6,000.00 per tap.
